Grasses



Common Name, Scientific Name, Description, Blooming Season, Location, Size

1. **Aztec Grass:** *Liriope muscari* 'Aztec'. An eye-catching, grass-like perennial with green and silver variegated foliage. A tough and easy to grow edging for pathways and borders. Adds texture and color contrast in mixed beds or containers. Blooms in the summer. Full sun, 15in tall and wide.
2. **Mondo Grass:** *Ophiopogon japonicus*, also known as monkey grass. It is an evergreen perennial that makes a great groundcover or stand-alone grass-like plant. Full or partial sun, 6-10 inches.
3. **Pampas Grass:** *Cortaderia selloana*. Poaceae (Grass Family) originating from South America. Large, dense, grassy mound, 6-10' x 6-10'. This grass produces tall, slim, weeping blades. Showy blooms in late summer and fall. Prefers full sun and can add texture to a garden. – **NEW Offering!!!**
4. **Purple Fountain Grass:** *Pennisetum setaceum* 'Rubrum'. Named for the arching spikes of nodding, purplish flowers that extend from its mass of long, slender, burgundy-colored leaves. Full or partial sun, 3-5ft tall.
5. **Flax Lily:** *Dianella* spp. Clumping, fast growing evergreen with small white or blue flowers. Blooms spring to mid-summer. Partial shade or full sun. 1-3ft tall.

6. **Agapanthus Ever Sapphire™:** *Agapanthus africanus* 'Andbin'. Semi-dwarf, fast growing, tough and drought tolerant. Blooms very early and reblooms with multiple spikes of bright blue flowers. Part sun. 1.5-2ft tall and 1-1.5ft wide.
7. **Agapanthus Everpanthus® Ever Midnight™:** *Agapanthus* Everpanthus® series. Ever Midnight blooms each spring and into the summer, meaning you can enjoy the intense dark blue flowers for months in a row! Partial sun. 2.5ft tall and 2ft wide.
8. **Blueberry 'Pink Lemonade':** *Vaccinium* × 'Pink Lemonade'. Pink Lemonade Blueberries typically ripen in late summer to early fall. Can be harvested once they turn a deep pink or purplish-red color. These berries have a sweet or slightly tart taste. Full Sun. 4.5ft tall and 4.5ft wide.
9. **Blueberry, Southern Highbush:** *Vaccinium corymbosum*. This upright, multi-stemmed, slow-growing deciduous shrub is planted for its edible fruit and beautiful fall color. Full sun to partial shade. 6-12ft tall.
10. **Evolvulus Blue Daze:** *Evolvulus glomeratus* is a tender, non-vining, herbaceous plant. It has brilliant blue flowers over a carpet of fuzzy, oval-shaped green leaves. Forms sprawling mounds 9 to 18 inches tall. Full sun or partial shade. – **NEW Offering!!!**
11. **Fiesta Hibiscus:** *Hibiscus rosa-sinensis* 'Fiesta'. Celebrated for its stunning blooms. The plant will add a festive touch to any garden. Boasts vibrant, multicolored flowers in shades of red, orange, yellow, and pink, creating a lively atmosphere. Full sunlight for at least six hours a day. 3-4ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**

12. **Firecracker Bush:** *Russelia equisetiformis*. Small plant that can have an explosive impact in your garden, attracting hummingbirds and butterflies. Its narrow, soft leaves give it a fine texture in the landscape. Typically blooms year-round with a profusion of red, tubular flowers. 3-4feet tall and 6+ feet wide. It can handle some shade, but prefers full sun. – **NEW Offering!!!**
13. **Gardenia, Frostproof:** *Gardenia jasminoides* 'Frostproof'. Gorgeous white blooms. Exhibits a zesty, floral scent with a peach undertone. Blooms in late spring. Can tolerate full sun or partial shade. 5ft tall and 4ft wide.
14. **Gardenia, Veitchii:** *Gardenia jasminoides* 'Veitchii'. Profusion of sweetly fragrant, white blooms that serve as excellent cut flowers. A beautiful specimen with upright branches that are covered with glossy evergreen foliage. Full to partial sun. 3-4ft tall and wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**
15. **Eclipse Hydrangea:** The Eclipse® Bigleaf Hydrangea is a shrub with dark purple leaves and red or purple flowers that bloom from late spring to fall. It's a low-maintenance plant that's disease-resistant, shade-tolerant, and can grow in a range of climates. Gorgeous amethyst or cranberry-colored blooms. 3-5 feet tall and wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**
16. **Nikko Blue Hydrangea:** *Hydrangea macrophylla* 'Nikko Blue'. Lush, green foliage and huge flowers. Full sun to part shade areas. Low-maintenance shrub. After each bloom, remove old blooms and it will bloom again! – **NEW Offering!!!**

The extremely large blooms can grow to 20 inches in length, presenting a fascinating display of color. Loves full sun. – **NEW Offering!!!**
19. **Plantain Lily Hosta:** *Hosta* sp. Forms a dome of medium green, shiny, deeply grooved leaves and pure white trumpets with an intense orange-blossom scent. It is a later blooming Hosta starting in August. The flowers last nearly a month. Prefers full sun or only part shade. – **NEW Offering!!!**
20. **Red Cluster Bottlebrush:** *Callistemon rigidus* 'Red Cluster'. Cylindrical, brush-like flowers make an appearance twice each year, once in the spring and again in summer. Attracts nectar-feeding birds. This shrub will serve as a stand-out in any landscape. 8-10ft tall and wide. Loves full sun. – **NEW Offering!!!**
21. **Rose Creek Abelia:** *Linnaea* x *grandiflora* 'Rose Creek'. Dense, compact shrub with white, slightly fragrant flowers produced from late spring to fall. These fragrant flowers attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Full sun or partial shade. 2-3ft tall.
22. **Mexican Petunia:** *Ruellia simplex*. Develops waves of blue, white, or pink petunia-like flowers through the summer. Mexican petunia is great choice for butterfly gardens because colorful insects flock to its sweet flowers. Blooms and grows best in full sun or partial shade. 3ft tall and wide. **NEW Offering!!!**
23. **'Silky Scarlet' Milkweed:** *Asclepias curassavica*. Deep red flower buds open to reveal red petals and a yellow hood that is hard to miss in the garden. They are a source of nectar for pollinators such as hummingbirds, bees, and butterflies. Full sun. 3-4ft tall

- 24. Society Garlic:** *Tulbaghia violacea*. Clump-forming herbaceous perennial with narrow, grass-like green leaves and clusters of small lilac flowers. Full sun. 1-2ft tall.
- 25. Sunshine Ligustrum:** *Ligustrum sinense* 'Sunshine'. Ideal as a hedge or standing alone in the landscape. Offers golden foliage that flourishes in full sun, 3-6ft tall.
- 26. Tea Olive, Apricot Echo:** *Osmanthus fragrans* var. *aurantiacus*. Produces abundant clusters of wonderfully fragrant apricot-colored blossoms. Blooms in fall and continues through the winter and early spring. Full sun. 10-15ft tall.
- 27. Tea Olive:** *Osmanthus fragrans*. This fragrant tea olive is a broadleaf, evergreen shrub with a dense habit in the Oleaceae (olive) family and is native to Asia. This plant has extremely fragrant, white flowers that appear in the spring and sporadically in the fall. Full sun to partial shade. 10-20 ft tall.
- 28. Tibouchina Glory Bush:** *Tibouchina urvilleana*. The beautiful showy purple flowers appear in terminal panicles. The evergreen leaves are dark green with lighter undersides and are 4-6 inches long. Plant is a magnet for pollinators and has a long bloom season. Full sun or partial shade. 2-10ft tall.
- 29. Alsike Clover:** *Trifolium hybridum*. Globular flowers are light pink to white. Its natural habitat includes moist meadows, pastures, abandoned fields, and roadsides. Full sun or partial shade. 1-3ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**

- 30. Azalea, Florida Flame:** *Rhododendron austrinum*. Brilliant, golden blossoms with a lovely honeysuckle fragrance in spring. Funnel-shaped flowers with protruding red stamens. Partial sun. 5-6ft tall and 3-4ft wide.
- 31. Azalea, Great Balls of Fire:** *Rhododendron* × 'Great Balls of Fire'. With flowers that light up and fill the garden with a wonderful spicy aroma, it is a rare deciduous rhododendron hybrid. It produces abundant, rounded clusters of 2-inch flowers in color tones from fiery to deep orange with very long pistils and stamens. Shade or mostly shade. 6-10ft tall and 4-6ft wide.
- 32. Azalea, Spring Fanfare:** *Rhododendron* Aromi Hybrid 'Spring Fanfare'. Large, rounded clusters of orange-red to yellow buds that open to exquisite, large, spicy-sweet scented flowers with ruffled, multi-color yellow petals exhibiting soft shades of coral-pink. Shade or filtered sun. Grows roughly 6-8ft tall and 4-6ft wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 33. Azalea, Spring Sensation:** *Rhododendron* Aromi Hybrid 'Spring Sensation'. Large, full, rounded clusters of soft pink, fragrant flowers that appear in late spring on this deciduous hybrid azalea. Full sun or partial shade. 6-8ft tall.
- 34. Azalea, Swamp:** *Rhododendron viscosum*. The sweet-scented flowers are white with a lavender tube that is slightly enlarged at the base. Blooms May through August. Prefers wet, shady areas. 5-15ft tall. **NEW Offering!!!**
- 35. American Fringe Tree:** *Chionanthus virginicus*. Small deciduous tree in the Oleaceae (olive family). Exhibits fragrant flower clusters with creamy white fringe-like petals. Full sun to partial shade. 12-20ft tall.

- 36. Beautyberry:** *Callicarpa americana*: American Beautyberry or French Mulberry. Long, arching branches and yellow-green fall foliage. The most striking feature is the clusters of glossy, iridescent-purple fruit. Blooms in the summer. Partial shade. 3-6ft tall and 4-6ft wide.
- 37. Blazing Star:** *Liatris spicata*. Blazing Star is an unforgettable, native perennial with electric purple flowers. Known for its grass-like foliage and tall, spiky blooms that attract butterflies, birds and bees. Partial sun and partial shade. 2-4ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 38. Blue Flag Iris:** *Iris versicolor*. Lovely blue blooms sit atop the green foliage. Excellent for planting around ponds, lakeshores, or any wet area. Full or partial sun. 2-3ft.
- 39. Coral Honeysuckle:** *Lonicera sempervirens*. Trumpet-shaped flowers that are red outside and yellow inside. This beautiful, slender, climbing vine is frequently visited by hummingbirds, butterflies and birds. Sun or part shade. 3-20ft long vines.
- 40. Firebush:** *Hamelia patens* 'Compacta'. Orange flowers tipped with gold set off the beauty of this dwarf firebush. It is a great butterfly plant for Florida home landscapes. This delightful shrub blooms on and off throughout the year. Full to partial sun. 3-5ft tall.
- 41. Florida Paintbrush:** *Carphephorus corymbosus*. Perennial herb that has showy, violet-colored flowers that resemble an artists paintbrush. Blooms in the fall and displays a compact head of small, bright purplish, tubular florets. Full sun to minimal shade. Up to 3ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**

- 42. Florida Prairie Iris:** *Iris savannarum*. Prairie iris is an excellent plant to enhance water features, lake edges, and retention ponds. Blooms in the spring. Full sun to partial shade. 2-3ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 43. Mock Orange:** *Philadelphus inodorus*. These fragrant deciduous shrubs are at their best in the spring and early summer when their aromatic white blooms attract bees and butterflies to the garden. The blooms make excellent cut flowers that fill a house with their signature scent. Full sun or partial sun. 3-10ft tall and 4-6ft wide.
- 44. Muhly Grass, Pink:** *Muhlenbergia capillaris*. This ornamental grass with clumping, pink tall flowers tolerates extreme drought and flooding. Blooms in fall. Full sun. 1-3ft tall.
- 45. Muhly Grass, Undaunted® Ruby:** *Muhlenbergia reverchonii* 'Pundo1s. Very showy, finely textured, bright reddish-pink seed heads provide an impressive late summer display of see-through amber-pink flower spikes. Prefers full sun. 2-3ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 46. Orange Coneflower:** *Rudbeckia fulgida*. Perennial coneflower with yellow-orange, slightly curved petals. Full sun. Roughly 4ft tall.
- 47. Purple Love Grass:** *Eragrostis spectabilis*. Exhibits of light to bright purple, giving an overall purple haze to the landscape. Blooms mid-summer and thrives in full sun and sandy sites. 1-2ft tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**

- 48. Red Anise, Florida:** *Illicium floridanum*. Small but very pretty red blooms on an outstanding, native shrub/small tree. Dense foliage and dark green leaves. Partial to full shade. 12-15ft tall.
- 49. Red Salvia:** *Salvia splendens*. Stunning red salvia flowers form a striking accent when massed together. Blooms in summer and early fall. Full sun to partial shade. 1-2ft tall and 9-18inches wide.
- 50. Simpsons Stopper:** *Myrcianthes fragrans*. The evergreen leaves can range in color from pale chartreuse to deep wine. The leaves are fragrant when crushed, giving off a spicy, citrus-like scent similar to nutmeg. Full sun to partial shade. 5-20ft tall.
- 51. Stokes Aster:** *Stokesia laevis*. This blue-lilac wildflower offers beauty with both its flowers and attractive, evergreen foliage. Showy native perennial that is an attractive and low-maintenance garden addition. Partial sun. 10-24inches tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 52. Swamp Chestnut Oak:** *Quercus michauxii*. The Swamp Chestnut Oak is a native deciduous tree with large saw-toothed leaves. Tree may grow 60 to 80 feet tall. The dense crown is rounded with an irregular spread. Full sun or partial shade. 60-80ft tall.
- 53. Swamp Milkweed:** *Asclepias incarnata*. The large, bright, terminal blossoms of this tall, showy perennial are made up of small, rose-purple flowers. Full sun or partial shade. 3-5ft tall and 2-3ft wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**

- 54. Woodland Phlox:** *Phlox divaricata*. Features fragrant, star-shaped flowers in shades of blue, lavender, or white. Blooms in the spring. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. Partial to full shade and prefers moist, well-drained soil. 12-18 inches tall. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 55. Yellow Canna:** *Canna glauca* 'Ra'. Yellow Canna Ra is adorned with large blue green leaves. From mid-summer to early fall this plant produces beautiful clusters of canary yellow flowers! Full sun. 4-6ft tall and 2-3ft wide

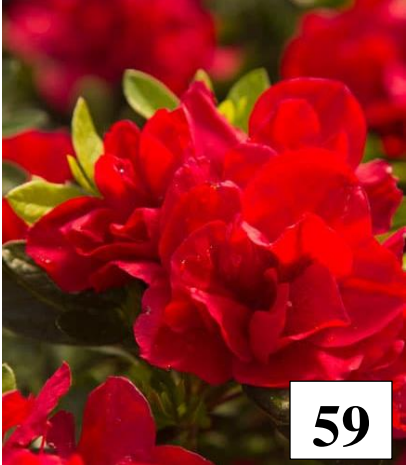

- 56. Autumn Coral®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Conled'. Beautiful coral pink with ruffled edges. Blooms profusely in spring, summer, and fall. Plants have dark, green foliage. Full sun or partial shade. 2.5-3ft tall and wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 57. Autumn Ivory®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Roblev'. Stunning clusters of white trumpet-shaped flowers at the ends of the branches. Blooms in the mid spring to early fall. It has dark green foliage. The glossy narrow leaves remain dark green throughout the winter. Full sun to partial shade. 2.5-3ft tall and wide – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 58. Autumn Sunset®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Roblen'. The massive red color display and the compact growth habit make this variety a fitting choice for any location. 3ft tall and 3.5ft wide.

- 59. Autumn Bonfire®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Robleza'. Has numerous, true red, semi-double and single blossoms. Blooms almost year-round, 3ft tall and 3.5ft wide.
- 60. Autumn Lily®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Roblex', White blooms with occasional single purple stripes. Blooms in the spring and summer, 4.5ft tall and 4ft wide.
- 61. Autumn Bravo®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Conlen'. Clusters of beautiful deep red blooms that will emerge all season. Blooms late spring to early fall. Full sun or partial shade. 4ft tall and wide. – **NEW Offering!!!**
- 62. Autumn Twist®:** *Rhododendron* × 'Conlep' PP12133, Fast growing variety boasts large dark pink and light pink bi-color and occasional solid purple blooms, Blooms in the spring and summer, 4.5ft tall and 4ft wide.

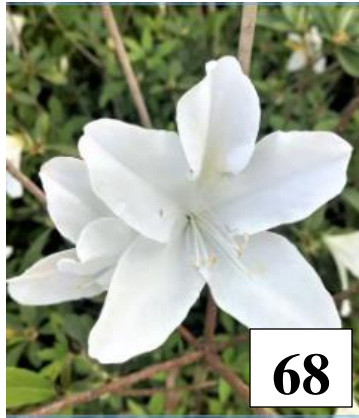

- 63. Lavender Formosa:** *Rhododendron* × 'Formosa Lavender'. Gorgeous lavender, pink flowers that are large and lovely with a dark pink/purple blotch on one side. Blooms early to mid-season each spring. Tolerant to full or partial sun. 4ft tall.
- 64. Conversation Piece:** *Rhododendron* × Robin Hill 'Conversation Piece'. Absolutely stunning flowers as large as four inches in diameter will cover this shrub when it is in bloom. The beautiful pink, white and red blossoms occur in the spring. Blooms in the spring and fall. 2-3ft tall.
- 65. Southern Charm:** *Rhododendron* × 'Southern Charm'. Broad-leaved evergreen shrubs with flamboyant pink blooms. Blooms early mid-season each spring. Full sun or partial shade. 6-8ft tall.
- 66. Duc Du Rohan:** *Rhododendron* 'Duc de Rohan'. A heavy bloomer with single salmon-pink flowers. Blooms early to late fall and into spring. 2-5ft tall.

- 67. George L. Taber:** *Rhododendron* 'George L. Taber'. Loads of 3 to 4-inch of these large showy, funnel-shaped flowers with variegated light orchid and white petals and fuchsia-purple centers that nearly cover the foliage of large, mounding evergreen shrubs. Blooms early-mid spring. Full sun or mostly sunny. 6-8ft tall.
- 68. Mrs. G.G. Gerbing:** *Rhododendron* 'Mrs. G.G. Gerbing'. Dense clusters of stunning, large white blooms cover this azalea in mid-spring. A compact shrub with attractive, ovate evergreen leaves. Full to partial sun. 8ft tall.
- 69. Vivid:** *Rhododendron* 'Vivid'. This azalea showcases bold, fiery red flowers that bloom in the spring. Deep green leaves provide a lush backdrop for its dazzling blooms. Plants can tolerate full or partial shade. 2-4ft tall.
- 70. Red Formosa:** *Rhododendron* 'Red Formosa'. Large evergreen foliage of deep dark green color that supports large red colored blooms covering the plant each spring. Shade to partial sun. 6-8ft tall.
